Patrol

- December 20th – Officer Snavelly responded to a shoplift call and during the arrest of the suspect, she could see drug paraphernalia and jewelry with tags still on them through the window of the suspect’s vehicle. The suspect said she had she taken the jewelry from the store. Vehicle was impounded pending a search warrant. December 27th – search warrant was served on vehicle. Recovered - stolen firearm, methamphetamine, heroin and evidence of drug sales.



- December 23rd – Police response to a domestic violence call – male suspect was reported to have a .22 caliber handgun on person and told victim that he would “kill a cop” and that police “would have to kill him before he goes to jail”. Officers with support from Lake Stevens and Snohomish police departments setup containment in the area. An Everett police K-9 was called to track the suspect. The K-9 found the suspect concealed in blackberry bushes .2 miles from the original incident. The male suspect was taken into custody and booked on Malicious Mischief 2nd DV charges and multiple warrants totaling \$60,000. Great work done by all
