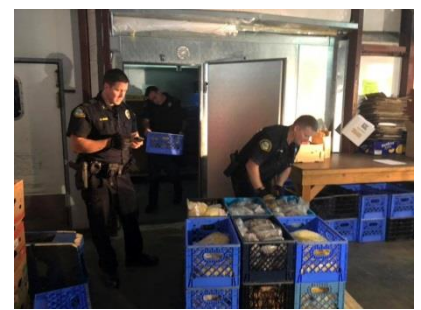

- **PATROL**

- **January 24th** – A 24-year old male from Monroe was taken into custody after two groping incidents in retail stores. The first occurred on January 17th and the second on the 22nd. Video from the store, transactions at the store and victim’s identification from photo montages linked the suspect to these two incidents. The suspect was booked into the Snohomish County Jail on Assault charges. Good work putting these two incidents together and making an arrest.
- **January 31st** - Dump truck took down wires and poles on Village Way. Electricity was lost in the area for approximately 10 hours. A call for help from the Sky Valley Food Bank brought City personnel over to help load 100’s of pounds of food to prevent spoilage.
