
• SIGNIFICANT CASES/EVENTS

- **June 24, 2020** – Officers responded to a shots fired incident in the 19900 block of Ravenwood Rd SE, Monroe. Several callers to 911 said there was a male in a small neighborhood park who had shot several shots in the air and appeared to be distraught and agitated. Upon arrival, officers observed the male with a gun to his neck. Officers contacted several homes in an attempt to have residents exit the area. They worked to negotiate a surrender for approximately 50 minutes before taking the male into custody without incident. The male was transported to EvergreenHealth for evaluation.






- **June 24, 2020** – A vehicle went off the roadway on Fryelands near SR 2. The driver was transported with shoulder injuries.


