City of Boise, Sit/Lie ordinance, Stay Out of Drug Area (SODA) ordinance, City budget, patrol struggles, measuring success, increase in reporting, pillars of investment/organization, generational homelessness, early intervention, focus on Monroe services, next steps in Monroe, Monroe resources, city and police department needs, resource card, public outreach and education, and community volunteers.
