

Passport Services

Items needed to obtain a Passport Book or Card:

Completed Passport Application Form DS-11

Available online at www.Travel.State.gov, or at Monroe City Hall.

Proof of Citizenship – A certified Birth Certificate, an expired Passport Book or Naturalization paperwork.

Photo Identification – A valid Washington State Driver's License, Military ID, or Government-issued ID.

Passport Quality Photo – Service available at City Hall for a \$15 fee.

Check or Money Order – paid to the U.S. Department of State. *Note: Each individual application needs one attached in order to process.*

An additional form of payment – paid to the City of Monroe for execution fee and/or photos.

Parents Present – both parents for minor children 16 years and younger. One parent for 16 and 17 year olds.

Previous issued Passport Book or Card

Current Processing Times:

4 - 6 weeks for routine processing

2 - 3 weeks for expedited processing

Passport Renewals Form DS-82:

The City does not process renewal applications.

Adult passports, that have been expired less than 5 years, need to submit a renewal application by mail to the U.S. Department of State.

All minors, age 15 and under who have or have not had a passport in the past must apply for a new passport in person.
