

ORDINANCE NO. 006/2012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON,
PROVIDING FOR AN ADVISORY VOTE ON ORDINANCE NO.
002/2007 AND CHAPTER 10.14 MMC AT THE NEXT GENERAL
ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF
MONROE:

Section 3. Advisory Vote: Any ordinance that authorizes the use
of automatic ticketing cameras enacted after January 1, 2007, must be
put on the ballot as an advisory vote of the people at the next general
election.

Section 4. Severability: If any provision of this act or its
application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder
of the act or the application of the provision to other persons or
circumstances is not affected.

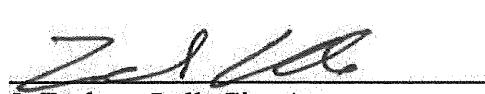
