

RESOLUTION 2012/003

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING FLUID CONSERVATION SYSTEMS AS THE SOLE SUPPLIER OF THE PERMALOG PLUS INTELLIGENT LEAK LOGGER SYSTEM WITH SENSUS AMR COMPATIBILITY

WHEREAS, State law and the City's own purchasing ordinance requires purchases of materials and supplies over \$15,000 a year to be competitively bid; and

WHEREAS, the City must purchase a permalog plus intelligent leak logger system with Sensus AMR compatibility at over the cost of the \$15,000 limit; and

WHEREAS, permalog plus technology has been determined the best option for our application; and

WHEREAS, Fluid Conservation Systems manufactures the only step intelligent leak logger system that is compatible with Sensus AMR technology; and

WHEREAS, a competitive bidding process would likely only produce one bid; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.23.352(9) authorizes sole source purchasing without calling for bids; and

WHEREAS, the statute requires a resolution by Council declaring an exemption from bidding under the sole source provision,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS: To declare Fluid Conservation Systems the sole source for permalog plus intelligent leak logger system with Sensus AMR compatibility.
