WHEREAS, the City owns that certain personal property listed in attached "Exhibit A"; and


WHEREAS, the personal property on Exhibit "A" is surplus to the needs of the City,




Attached for your review, is a list of one (1) vehicle(s) that have exceeded their service life and need to be deemed surplus and sold.
