A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MONROE, WASHINGTON, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING
DATE AT WHICH TO CONSIDER THE VACATION OF A
PORTION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY OF 171ST AVENUE

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Monroe, State of Washington, praying for the vacation of a portion of a street located on 171st Avenue, described in Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, petitioner appear to be the owners of property abutting upon the portion of said street sought to be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


That Tuesday, January 8, 2019, at approximately the hour of 7:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers at 806 W. Main St., Monroe, Washington, at the regular meeting of the City Council to be held on said date, be, and the same hereby, is fixed as the time of hearing on said vacation; and the City Clerk is hereby ordered to give twenty days' notice of the pendency of the vacation by posting written notice thereof in three most public places in the City of Monroe and a like notice in a conspicuous place in the street right-of-way to be vacated. The three most public places are hereby declared to be the City Hall, the Monroe Library, and the Office of the Public Utility District No. 1.
