RESOLUTION NO. 009/2019**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, DESIGNATING FOOTHILLS WETLAND PRESERVE AS THE NAME OF THE CITY-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED NORTH OF US-2 AND EAST OF ROOSEVELT ROAD WITHIN THE CITY OF MONROE

WHEREAS, Students from our schools are participating in a naming contest for the City-owned wetland preserve located north of US-2 and east of Roosevelt Road; and

WHEREAS, The naming contest is required as part of an educational component to a \$109,000 State Conservation Commission grant award for restoration of the wetland fed by Cripple Creek; and

WHEREAS, The grant project included the planting of over ten thousand willow stakes last year and the City of Monroe has partnered with lead agency Snohomish Conservation District to achieve this important environmental improvement; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish Conservation District staff received one hundred and sixty-eight submissions from Monroe students, which were then narrowed down by a review team of community members who selected a top list of names: Foothills Wetland Preserve, Evergreen Wetland Preserve, M. Town Wetland Preserve, Sunrise Wetland Preserve, Mejur Agua Wetland Preserve, Monroe Wetland Preserve, and Naturaleza Wetland Preserve; and

WHEREAS, The Monroe Park Board reviewed the top list of names and made a recommendation to the Monroe City Council of Foothills Wetland Preserve as a name for the City-owned wetland preserve located north of US 2 and east of Roosevelt Road within the City of Monroe, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Designation. Foothills Wetland Preserve is hereby designated as the name for the City-owned wetland preserve located north of US-2 and east of Roosevelt Road within the City of Monroe, Washington.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Monroe, at its regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 11th day of May, 2019.
