A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MONROE, WASHINGTON, REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR
THE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND ASSISTANCE
PROGRAM YOUTH ACTIVITIES BUILDING ADDITION
PROJECT

WHEREAS, On October 22, 2019 the City of Monroe (hereinafter referred to as "City") authorized a contractual agreement with Washington State Department of Commerce, Grant Number 20-96624-002, to complete design and construction of an Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program facility addition to be operated by the Monroe Boys & Girls Club at the Monroe Youth Activities Building; and

WHEREAS, following advertisement in the Daily Journal of Commerce, formal sealed bids for the construction of said project were accepted by the City on August 26, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe has reviewed the responsive bids; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the low bid would cause expenditures for the project to exceed the City's grant award amount; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.23.352(1), the City Council desires to reject all bids received for said project by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Monroe, Washington, does hereby formally reject all bids for construction of the Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program facility addition at the Monroe Youth Activities Building.

Section 2. That all bid deposits received by the City shall be returned to the bidders with notification of the rejection.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
