

**CITY OF MONROE
RESOLUTION NO. 022/2020**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MONROE, WASHINGTON, REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR
DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS SECOND RESERVOIR
PROJECT.

WHEREAS, On January 22, 2019 the City of Monroe (hereinafter referred to as "City") authorized preparation of plans, specifications, cost estimation, and solicitation of bids for the Department of Corrections Second Reservoir project; and

WHEREAS, following advertisement in the Daily Journal of Commerce, formal sealed bids for the construction of said project were accepted by the City on September 23, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe has reviewed the responsive bids; and

WHEREAS, the City received an official bid protest focusing on the First-Tier Subcontractor Disclosure Form of Section 00 21 16.30 Project Specifications; and

WHEREAS, the City has evaluated said protest, including the potential delay and additional cost that would be incurred in resolving the issue, and has determined the most expedient and cost-effective course of action would be to reject all bids, and then to rebid the project with clarified bidder criteria; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.23.352(1), the City Council desires to reject all bids received for said project by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Monroe, Washington, does hereby formally reject all bids for construction of the Department of Corrections Second Reservoir project.

Section 2. That all bid deposits received by the City shall be returned to the bidders with notification of the rejection.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
