Collision under investigation; Pedestrian seriously injured

MONROE – March 5th, 2022: At 6:53 p.m., Monroe Police Officers responded to the 300 block of South Lewis Street for a car vs. pedestrian collision. There, officers and citizen bystanders provided medical aid to the entrapped driver who was the single occupant in a flipped over SUV. Officers also provided aid to the seriously injured female pedestrian, found lying on the sidewalk. Both the driver and pedestrian were transported to local hospitals by Snohomish Regional Fire & Rescue.

A sign to the Monroe United Methodist Church was struck and damaged in the collision. Additionally, a dog belonging to the driver of the SUV was described as fleeing the scene, running northbound on Lewis Street. The dog is described as half mastiff, half black lab. His name is “Cuse”. Anyone seeing or finding the dog is asked to call 911 so we can help reunite him with his owner.

The circumstances leading up to the collision remain under investigation. No arrests have been made.
