NATIONAL NIGHT OUT: THANK YOU

I wanted to again extend a thank you to all the community members, staff, and organizations who came together last week on August 6 to participate in National Night Out Against Crime. In 2023, Monroe's National Night Out had approximately 3,300 attendees. I am happy to share that this year over 4,000 visitors attended the event making it the largest turnout at National Night Out since 2020.

The City is currently accepting applications to fill one mid-term vacancy on our Community Human Services Advisory Board (CHSAB). CHSAB advises the Mayor and City Council on programs and policies to persons experiencing homelessness, at risk of becoming homeless, living in poverty, adversely affected by crisis, and those in marginalized communities.

The seven-member board is comprised of community members who live, work, or serve in the Monroe community and have been appointed to their positions by the Mayor and Council. The **Evergreen State Fair** officially begins Thurs., Aug. 22. With 11 days and nights of fun and excitement ahead, traffic impacts are also coming. Please be patient if you're driving to, from, or near the fairgrounds during the Fair. Our Police Department will be directing traffic and conducting emphasis patrol in the area. We ask that you:

KEY FACTS ABOUT PROPOSITION 1: PARKS & PUBLIC SAFETY

In the November 2024 general election, City of Monroe voters will consider **Proposition 1** to support investment in parks maintenance and public safety services. Below are some quick facts about **Proposition 1**:

- *Addresses community priorities for quality parks, recreation, and public safety.*
- *Placed on Nov. 5, 2024, General Election ballot.*
- *Exempts qualifying low-income seniors, disabled veterans, and others with disabilities.*
- *Requires simple majority vote of City of Monroe voters.*
- *Sets Monroe's property tax levy rate at \$1.08/\$1,000 Assessed Value (AV).*
- *Increases current levy rate by \$0.22/\$1,000 (AV).*
- *Costs average Monroe homeowner approximately \$10.84 more a month paid to the City.*
- *Provides a little more than \$1 million/year to permanently support parks maintenance staffing and equipment and address current demands and permanently fund a second Community Services Officer and one public safety position in the Police Department.*
