**Recognizing the artwork of
David Hose**



WHEREAS, David Hose has painted numerous murals, portraits, and landscapes across the Skykomish River Valleys, including the City of Monroe; and

WHEREAS, David Hose was first commissioned in the City of Monroe by the Monroe Arts Council in 2004 for a mural on North Lewis Street; and

WHEREAS, David Hose has continued to be an active member and artist in the Monroe community, strengthening local connections through community-centered artwork that helps create a place where everyone feels at home, and everyone feels they belong; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe contracted with David Hose and American Light Studios in July 2023 to commission a mural painting highlighting the City's vision statement, *Imagine Monroe*, by portraying the past, present, and future aspirations of the City of Monroe, Washington; and

WHEREAS, in October 2024, David Hose completed the commissioned mural that will be displayed at the new City Hall Council Chambers.
