A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE,  
WASHINGTON, CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S PROCLAMATION  
DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE CITY OF MONROE,  
WASHINGTON ON DECEMBER 11, 2025.

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WHEREAS, a severe weather event, specifically an atmospheric river resulting in widespread flooding, began on or about December 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS, flooding levels peaked on or about December 11, 2025, and continues to impact Snohomish County and the City of Monroe as water levels subside; and

WHEREAS, this event caused extensive damage to public and private property, including critical infrastructure, roads, bridges, parks, and homes, and has posed a significant threat to public safety; and

WHEREAS, the rainfall and flooding conditions threatened and continues to threaten life, property, and the continuity of essential public services within the City of Monroe; and

WHEREAS, emergency management officials have determined that the severity of this incident exceeds the capacity of local resources to adequately respond to and recover from its impacts; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2025, Mayor Geoffrey Thomas proclaimed a State of Emergency within the City of Monroe pursuant to Chapter 2.60 of the Monroe Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Confirmation of Declaration of Emergency. Pursuant to Chapter 2.60.050 of the Monroe Municipal Code, the Monroe City Council hereby confirms the proclamation issued by Mayor Geoffrey Thomas on December 11, 2025, creating a Declaration of Emergency in the City of Monroe, Washington.

Section 2. Conditions of Termination. The emergency proclamation shall remain in effect until terminated by the Mayor by Proclamation or terminated by City Council by Ordinance pursuant to Chapter 2.60.050 of the Monroe Municipal Code and RCW 35A.38.010.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
