



Monroe Police Investigate Shooting; Victim in Serious Condition

MONROE, Wash. – A 31-year-old Monroe man was seriously injured in a shooting late last night near the 100 block of East Main Street.

At approximately 11:33 p.m., the Monroe Police Department received multiple 911 calls reporting gunshots outside a local bar. Patrons inside the business reported hearing the shots and immediately taking cover. Witnesses reported that, aside from the victim, those involved fled the area on foot in an unknown direction.

When officers arrived, they located the victim suffering from a gunshot wound to the chest. Officers provided medical aid until EMS personnel arrived. The victim was transported to a hospital in Everett, where he remains in serious condition. Officers processed the scene and collected evidence related to the crime.

Detectives are actively following up on leads regarding the identity of the shooter. The investigation remains ongoing; however, early information suggests the shooting may have been the result of a dispute involving individuals known to each other.
