

**CITY OF MONROE
RESOLUTION NO. 2025-007**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING FLOCK SAFETY AS THE SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER OF THE FLOCK SAFETY CAMERA SYSTEM, AND WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY'S PURCHASE OF SAID EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Flock Safety LPR (license plate recognition) and PTZ (pan-tilt-zoom) camera systems were designed to support law enforcement operations and investigations by utilizing technology that increases efficiency, places officers in areas where criminal activity is occurring, and ultimately solves more crimes; and

WHEREAS, Flock Safety is the only authorized supplier offering Flock Safety LPR Cameras, PTZ cameras, gunshot detection devices, and associated services in a combined system that provides law enforcement with pertinent public safety information in near real time; and

WHEREAS, the City's local purchasing policies generally require competitive bidding for purchases of materials, equipment, and supplies over \$40,000; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Monroe Police Department to purchase the above-referenced Flock Safety hardware and software products in an estimated amount exceeding the cost limit above; and

WHEREAS, the City's purchasing policies authorize sole source purchasing without calling for bids with respect to purchases that are clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply; and

WHEREAS, based upon the foregoing, the City Council has carefully and in good faith determined that the Flock Safety camera system is clearly and legitimately limited to a single source or supply, and that a competitive bidding process for this purchase would be ineffective and wasteful; and

WHEREAS, Flock Safety has certified in writing that the City is getting the lowest offered price with respect to this equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The above recitals, together with the content of Agenda Bill 25-125, are hereby adopted as findings in support of this resolution.

Section 2. Sole Source Purchasing Authorized. Flock System is hereby declared as the sole source of supply for the Flock Safety hardware and software products. The otherwise-applicable competitive purchasing requirements for the acquisition of said equipment are hereby waived. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to acquire said equipment on the City's behalf in accordance with this resolution.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
