A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR MONROE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 103 PROPOSITION NO. 1, BONDS TO BUILD, REPAIR, REPLACE AND IMPROVE SCHOOL FACILITIES - \$152,048,846; AND ENTERING SUPPORTIVE FINDINGS.

WHEREAS, Monroe School District No. 103 has submitted a proposition (Proposition No. 1) to local voters for inclusion on the February 10, 2026, special election ballot authorizing a replacement of expiring educational programs and operations levy in the form indicated in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full; and

WHEREAS, the stated purpose of Proposition No. 1 is to authorize the District to improve building, safety and security systems districtwide; create the new Sky Valley Education Center at the Wagner Center; build a gym and remodel portions of Frank Wagner Elementary; modernize the Salem Woods gym and add classroom; enhance special education and early learning facilities; improve athletic fields and expand public access by issuing \$152,048,846 of general obligation bonds maturing within 21 years; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 29B.45.010, the Monroe City Council desires to formally express its support for Proposition No. 1 and urge its approval by local voters.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The above recitals are hereby adopted by reference as findings in support of this resolution. The City Council further enters the following additional findings:

A. Education of local children is of paramount importance and constitutes a fundamental government purpose.

B. The vast majority of school children residing in Monroe attend schools operated by Monroe School District No. 103.

C. Approval of Proposition No. 1 would advance the public interest by equipping Monroe students with the educational facilities necessary for successful school operations and classroom learning.

D. The City Council desires to formally express its support of Proposition No. 1.

E. The City followed the procedural requirements set forth at RCW 29B.45.010 in passing this resolution. This resolution was discussed and passed at an open public meeting on January 27, 2026. The meeting notice contained the information required by RCW 29B.45.010 (1), and members of the City Council, as well as members of the public, were afforded an equal opportunity at the meeting to express an opposing view.

Section 2. Expression of Support. Based upon the above findings, the Monroe City Council hereby formally expresses its support for Proposition No. 1.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Monroe, at its regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2026.

The Board of Directors of Monroe School District No. 103 approved Resolution #6-2025 concerning a proposition for bonds to provide safe, modern facilities. This proposition would authorize the District to improve building, safety and security systems districtwide; create the new Sky Valley Education Center at the Wagner Center; build a gym and remodel portions of Frank Wagner Elementary; modernize the Salem Woods gym and add classroom; enhance special education and early learning facilities; improve athletic fields and expand public access by issuing \$152,048,846 of general obligation bonds maturing within 21 years; and levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds.
