

## RESOLUTION 2013/018

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO WORK COOPERATIVELY WITH THE MONROE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND EVERETT COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO EXPLORE AND ANALYZE PROJECTS OF MUTUAL INTEREST AND PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe has determined that improvement of the Monroe High School ball fields would be a worthwhile project to jointly fund with the Monroe School District;

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe has sought and obtained a grant for improvements to the Monroe High School ball fields; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe wishes to work collaboratively with the Monroe School District on transportation improvement initiatives important to all citizens;

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe wishes to construct an outdoor stage at Lake Tye Park adjacent to Fryelands Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe believes that it would be of mutual benefit to consider seeking joint funding for a new administrative services building that would house Monroe City Hall, Monroe Municipal Court, Monroe School Administration, and Everett Community College classes; and

WHEREAS, THE City of Monroe believes that it would be of mutual benefit to jointly procure necessary goods, services, and materials used by each entity; and

WHEREAS, the use of donations, volunteers, and non-profit contributions to help fund and complete civic projects promotes volunteerism and allows community participation, benefitting all citizens; and

WHEREAS, local governmental entities can be good stewards of the public's funds by working together cooperatively to reach common goals;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Monroe, Washington, authorizes City staff to work with the Monroe School District and Everett Community College to research and analyze the aforementioned projects to determine their viability.


**Section 2.** The City Council of the City of Monroe hereby invites the Monroe School District and Everett Community college to join the City of Monroe to research and analyze the aforementioned projects to determine their viability.

**Section 3.** The City Council of the City of Monroe hereby supports partnering with the Monroe School District and Everett Community college to seek joint funding for projects that would be mutually advantageous.

**Section 4.** The City Council of the City of Monroe authorizes City staff to work with the School District and Everett Community College to determine what goods, services, and/or materials can be cooperatively purchased to save time, effort, or funds.
