WHEREAS, the personal property on Exhibit A is surplus to the needs of the City; and


WHEREAS, the Monroe City Council has held a public hearing regarding this matter per RCW 35.94.040 on July 15, 2014.

ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Monroe, at its regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 15 day of July, 2014.


