

## **City of Monroe Boards, Commissions, Committees Membership Requirements (residency, etc.)**

**Civil Service** – must be citizen of United States, reside within city limits for at least three years before appointment, and be a registered voter of Snohomish County.

**Community Human Services Advisory Board (CHSAB)** – Seven voting members, representing a cross section of local residents, businesses, faith communities, and service providers, and the City of Monroe.

**Economic Development Advisory Board (EDAB)** – Seven voting members, representing a cross section of the business community.

**Ethics Board** - must be citizens of the United States and residents of the city for at least one year before their appointment. No member may be a public official, city employee or immediate family of either.

**Law Enforcement Officers' and Firefighters' retirement plan 1 (LEOFF-1) Board** - Two members of the city council, to be appointed by the mayor; Two active or retired law enforcement officers employed by or retired from the city, to be elected by the law enforcement officers employed by or retired from the city who are subject to the jurisdiction of the board. All law enforcement officers employed by or retired from the city are eligible for election; One member from the public at large who resides within the city, to be appointed by the other four members designated in this section.

**Lodging Tax Advisory Committee (LTAC)** – Two members who are representatives of hotel-motel businesses required to collect the lodging tax (business) and Two members who are persons involved in activities authorized to be funded by revenue received from the lodging tax (activities).

**Park Board** - The members shall reside within the limits of the city of Monroe, except the mayor may appoint, subject to confirmation by the city council, one board member from the city of Monroe's urban growth area to fill a vacant position.

**Planning Commission** - All members of the planning commission shall reside within the city limits of the city of Monroe, except the mayor may appoint and the city council confirm one commissioner from the city of Monroe's urban growth area to fill a vacant position.

**Salary Commission** - A member of the commission shall not be an officer, official, or employee of the city or an immediate family member of an officer, official, or employee of the city.
