Parks and Public Safety Services Levy – Proposition 1

2024 November General Election

City of Monroe Proposition 1

In the November 2024 general election, Monroe voters will consider [Proposition 1](#) to support or reject investment in parks maintenance and public safety services. If approved by voters, Proposition 1 would allow the City to set its levy rate to \$1.08 per \$1,000 of assessed value (AV), an increase of \$0.22/\$1,000 AV. The maximum levy rate is capped at \$1.60/\$1,000 AV. More information about Proposition 1 can be found at MonroeWA.gov.

Committee Members Needed (Pro and Con):

The City of Monroe is responsible for appointing members of the pro and con committees to prepare statements to appear in the voters' pamphlet in favor of and in opposition to the "Parks and Public Safety Services Levy" ballot measure. Pro and con committees consist of three members of the public, but each may seek the advice of others not on the committee. Only committee members' names will be included with the statement.

Committee Member Duties:

The pro and con committees submit statements in favor of and in opposition to the ballot measure (respectively) for the local voters' pamphlet. Each committee must designate a chair who is the primary contact for the [Snohomish County Auditor's Elections Office](#) and will be responsible for submitting the committee's statement containing the signatures or approval of each member. The [Elections Office](#) works directly with pro/con committees once they are appointed by the City.

Pro and con statements are to be submitted to the [Elections Office](#) no later than 5 p.m. on August 16, 2024, regardless of postmark. Once the statements have been received and reviewed, they will be emailed to the opposing committee for rebuttal. Rebuttal statements are due by 5 p.m. on August 21, 2024.
