In the November 5, 2024 general election, Monroe voters will consider Proposition 1 to support investment in parks maintenance and public safety services:

- ✓ Restore parks maintenance staffing to and address current service demands.
- ✓ Fund a second full-time Community Services Officer to provide 7 days/week coverage to respond to nuisance and animal control issues.
- ✓ Fund a public safety position in the Police Department that would best support community needs.

On average, if this levy is approved, Monroe homeowners will pay \$10.84 more per month in property taxes.

Eligible low-income seniors, disabled veterans, and other people with disabilities would be exempt from paying the increased levy rate.
