RESOLUTION NO. 2024-025**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MONROE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE CITY OF
MONROE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE, AND FEES, FINES,
PENALTIES, INTEREST AND CHARGES TO BE
EFFECTIVE FOR JANUARY 1, 2025

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Monroe has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Monroe to provide a single, efficient, and convenient listing of all fees, fines, penalties, interest, and charges for permits, licenses, services, applications and filing fees; and

WHEREAS, such a listing better facilitates the updating and uniform review of all such fees, fines, penalties, interest and charges on a periodic basis; and

WHEREAS, previous resolutions provide for fees that require review from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Master Fee Schedule of Fees, Fines, Penalties, Interest and Charges for 2024 were adopted through Resolution No. 2023-018 and amended through Resolution No. 2024-011; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Master Fee Schedule, Schedule A, General Development Permits and Fees, updates the General Development Permits and Fees to reflect the recent reduction and/or elimination of various school impact fees for the Monroe School District and Snohomish School District due to declining student enrollment and based on analyses as performed by the respective school districts. The binding site plan fee has been divided into two parts; a preliminary binding site plan fee and a final binding site plan fee, to better reflect plan review work flow and recover staffing costs, and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Master Fee Schedule, Schedule B, Plumbing and Mechanical Fees, increases pretreatment interceptor fees and backflow inspection fees to cover the cost of staff time; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Master Fee Schedule, Schedule F, Utility Rates, increases meter deposits to reflect increased cost of materials, labor and equipment to install replacement meters, and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Master Fee Schedule, Schedule H, Park Related Services, reflect increased uses fees for the City's park facilities (picnic shelters and fields) to ensure sufficient investment in parks and recreational facilities. The fees do not provide for full cost recovery of park facilities as they are carefully balanced with the community's ability to pay.

WHEREAS, amendments to the Master Fee Schedule I, Fire District Related Service, is amended to update the effective date of the Snohomish Regional Fire and Rescue Fee Schedule as prepared by the fire district and available on its website.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of Master Fee Schedule, Schedules A, B, F, H, and I. The City of Monroe Master Fee Schedule, Schedule A – General Development Permits and Fees, Schedule B – Plumbing and Mechanical Fees, Schedule F – Utility Rates, Schedule H – Park Related Services, and Schedule I – Fire District Related Service, are hereby amended as attached.

Section 2. Master Fee Schedule, Schedules C, D, E, and G. The City of Monroe Master Fee Schedule C – Regulatory Licenses and Permits, Schedule D – Penalties, Fines, Late Charges & Interest Rates, Schedule E – Municipal Court Fees, and Schedule G – Miscellaneous Charges remain unchanged as attached.

Section 3. Effective Date. The City of Monroe Master Fee Schedule, and fees, fines, penalties, interest, and charges, as amended, will be effective January 1, 2025, unless otherwise noted in the attached schedules or as otherwise provided by ordinance.

SCHEDULE A
General Development Permits and Fees

A mailing-fee of \$75 will be due upon submittal for land use applications, appeals, and SEPA determinations, subject to public notice. A minimum deposit of \$75 will be due upon submittal for Environmental Impact Statements and Annexations; the actual mailing costs will be due when the fee is determined. No mailing fees are charged for Administrative Design Review, Boundary Line Revisions, Forest Practices, and Land Clearing Permits.

A publication fee of \$100 will be due upon submittal for land use applications, appeals, and SEPA determinations subject to public notice. Shoreline Permit Applications will be charged a \$150 publication fee. No publication fees are charged for Administrative Design Review, Boundary Line Revisions, Forest Practices, and Land Clearing Permits.

PERMITS

-  Plan review fees, in addition to permit fees, are assessed at a rate of 75 percent of the calculated permit fee and are due at time of application submittal.
- Permit fees are due at time of issuance.
- A state surcharge fee will be added to all permits with the exception of mechanical, plumbing, and fire permits. Staff will apply changes as amended by the State Building Code Council.
- Extension fees are due at the time of request for permit extension.
- Downtown Area Fee Waiver – Notwithstanding the fee waiver authorized under Ordinance No. 013/2023, properties located in the Downtown Area shall be fully subject to the same penalties for regulatory and/or permitting noncompliance and violations as any other property in Monroe city limits. Without limitation of the

foregoing, if work requiring a building permit is performed without first obtaining a permit, the applicant shall be charged two times the fee amount established in Table 1-A Building Fee Table and Table 103.4.2(A).
